General. The following provisions apply to the required insurance coverage set forth above:

- a. Supplier will purchase the required insurance from companies having a rating of A VII or better in the current Best's Insurance Reports published by A.M. Best Company, Inc. Supplier must provide ORBIS with thirty (30) days advance written notice of any material change in or the cancellation of any insurance policy.
- b. Supplier will cause ORBIS and its affiliates, and each of their respective directors, officers, employees, successors, assigns, and agents of ORBIS to be named as additional insureds (other than Workers' Compensation and Employers' Liability) with the standard separation of insureds provision or an endorsement for cross-liability coverage.
- c. Supplier will cause each of its policies of insurance to waive any right of subrogation on the part of the insurer against ORBIS, its directors, officers, employees, agents, and contractors (to the extent permitted by law). The insurance maintained by Supplier will be primary to, and without any right of contribution from, any other insurance that may be available to ORBIS.

Submission of Certificate of Insurance. Supplier will submit certificates of insurance for the coverage required above to ORBIS prior to the start of any work and/or provision of any goods, and at each insurance policy renewal thereafter.

Other Obligations. The existence of Supplier's insurance policies or ORBIS' approval thereof, does not relieve or limit any of Supplier's other obligations under any purchase order issued by ORBIS or other agreement entered into between ORBIS and Supplier.
